This scholarship is in honor of Lisa Renee Lee, a fellow Collierville Dragon, and in memory of Jancy James Lee and Vincent Bernard Lee. This endowment seeks to bless a student with a means to continue their education at a higher institute of learning.

Mr. James Lee was the Maintenance Director for ServiceMaster Facilities Maintenance Company. He was a firm believer in supporting and giving back to his community, a trait that he passed on to his children Vincent and Lisa. His passing from lung cancer in 2019 sparked his daughter to start this legacy of support for this community.

Vincent Lee, President and CEO of ServiceMaster Facilities Maintenance Company, preceded his father in death succumbed by cancer in 2018. Vincent was a man of humble beginnings that led the largest janitorial franchise in the history of ServiceMaster Clean.
